

MARKET UPDATE

A Sign of The Market Cooling Off? Greater Boston Real Estate Board August Market Reports show a decline in sales from August 2020.

NEWS

Highlights from the report:

- Single-family homes sales fell 2.4% year over year (1,552 homes compared to the 1,590 homes sold in August of 2020)
- Single family sales volume decreased 8.4% from July
- August 2021 was the 10th most active August on record for home sales
- Condominium sales grew from last August, up 13.4% (1,299 compared to 1,146 in 2020)
- Condo sales activity slowed from July dropping 10.2%.
- August was the fifth-highest August on record for condo sales.
