Along with Family Health Teams, specialized healthcare services, and community health initiatives. The public health sector of KFL&A is annually recognized as one of the top in Ontario. In 2022 Kingston was rated as having one of the top 40 hospitals in Canada.

Education

Kingston, Ontario, is home to a range of esteemed educational institutions. Queen's University stands out as a prestigiously renowned research-intensive university, offering diverse undergraduate and graduate programs. St. Lawrence College provides diploma and certificate programs across various disciplines, and the Royal Military College of Canada (RMC) specializes in education and training for members of the Canadian Forces. The Limestone District School Board oversees public primary and secondary education, and the Algonquin and Lakeshore Catholic District School Board manages Catholic schools in the region, both of which offering French Immersion ciriculum options.



Recreation

Kingston West provides diverse recreational opportunities, with parks like Cataraqui Conservation Area offering green spaces and walking trails. The waterfront along Lake Ontario invites activities such as walking and cycling while enjoying scenic views. Sports enthusiasts can access facilities such as the Invista Centre, a state of the art 4-pad hockey arena, fitness centre, outdoor track & turf football field. Other recreational centres offer fitness classes, swimming, and various indoor activities in the area such as the YMCA & Boys & Girls Club. Cultural and community events, including festivals and markets can also be found nearby. For those seeking recreational activities, nearby parks, sports facilities, and cultural venues that provide opportunities for entertainment and leisure, all while embracing overall lifestyle envisioned for the Terra Verde Community.

Location

Terra Verde is ideally located in Kingston's West End and the gateway to the four-tower community will be the southeast tower at 1165 Centennial Drive. The location is ideal placing you minutes away from all of the west-end end amenities from shopping (Cataraqui Town Centre, Walmart, Shoppers, Rio-Can Centre & more), restaurants (including a cafe just a stroll away), essential services, entertainment, recreational (InVista Community Centre), schools, professional services and so much more. The site is just a 15-minute stroll or short bike ride to the infamous Cataraqui Trail and offers convenient access to the city and 401 Highway. Historic Downtown
